

Squash Yukon Funding Support Policy

Introduction

As part of Squash Yukon's mandate to promote the participation in squash, members of Squash Yukon are supported by the Executive in their endeavours to apply for the various sources of funding aimed at achieving this goal.

Any member seeking funding from available funding sources (including Sports Yukon High Performance Funding programs (Athlete, Official and Coaching), Yukon Lotteries grants or other applicable grants where the Sports Governing Body support is required) will be required to meet the conditions set by Squash Yukon and as detailed below in order to obtain continued funding.

Squash Yukon Funding Eligibility

All members of Squash Yukon will be supported in seeking funding from outside sources such as the Yukon Government / Sport and Recreation Branch High Performance Athlete / Coach / Official program or Yukon Lotteries providing:

- The applicant is a Squash Yukon member in good standing.
- The applicant meets the guidelines laid out for the funding program by the program sponsors.

High Performance Athlete Funding

All members of Squash Yukon who are in good standing will be supported in the endeavours to seek High Performance Athlete Funding. Successful applicants must be enrolled in an approved training program developed by the Squash Yukon Head Coach that will include:

- Ongoing program of lessons approved by the Head Coach
- Participation in Squash Yukon tournaments
- Maintenance of an athlete's log

High Performance Coaching Funding

All members of Squash Yukon who are in good standing will be supported in their endeavours to seek High Performance Coaching Funding. Successful High Performance Coaching applicants must:

- assist the Head Coach as outlined by the Squash Yukon Executive and in the year funding is received.
- submit in writing to Squash Yukon a brief overview of the training / upgrading received and voluntary work carried out.

High Performance Officials Funding

All members of Squash Yukon who are in good standing will be supported in their endeavours to seek High Performance Officials Funding. Successful High Performance Officials applicants must:

- assist the Squash Yukon as outlined by the Squash Yukon Executive and in the year funding is received.
- submit in writing to Squash Yukon a brief overview of the training / upgrading received and voluntary work carried out.

Canadian National Team Championship Selection Eligibility

All members of Squash Yukon who are in good standing will be eligible for selection to represent Squash Yukon in the Canadian National Team Championships. Teams will be selected from all eligible players who have registered their desire to participate in the event and who have participated in the training program laid out by the Head Coach. A selection panel will consist of the Squash Yukon Head Coach and the President of Squash Yukon or his stand in and the following selection guidelines used:

- team selection format will be set by Squash Yukon prior to team tryouts
- as the Canadian National Team Championships is the only Open national tournament that Squash Yukon is officially represented at, preference will be given to adult players when selecting representative teams. (Squash Yukon participates in three Junior tournaments outside the Yukon which gives all junior players the opportunity to compete at higher levels of play which are not available locally.)
- juniors will be allowed to participate if there are insufficient numbers of adult players interested in attending. If a junior does participate, that player will be responsible for ensuring that (s)he has an adult chaperone in accordance with the Junior Travel Policy
